Key Points for Infection Prevention

Course Description

This presentation will examine infection control principles. Participants will learn about the transmission of infectious agents, the importance of standard precautions, and the role of sterilization and disinfection protocols in preventing the spread of infections. The course will also cover regulatory requirements and guidelines set forth by organizations such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).
